We are proud to announce a newly-established **Young B.R.A.I.N.** award to coincide with this year's **Asia Nutrition Forum (ANF)** to be held in **Seoul, South Korea on 17th October 2019**. This award seeks to support a young and highly motivated scientist, to nurture continuing innovation and research, involving innovative feed additive application and solutions.

We invite interested applicants to submit their research project(s), which should include and demonstrate disruptive innovations to solve **animal health** and/or **nutrition related** issues in the **livestock industry**.

- Resume
- Reference & approval from the applicant's academic supervisor to apply for the award
- A report (maximum of 1000 words) outlining the research study and its practical application to advancing animal nutrition and/or animal health in the livestock industry.

The winner of the Young B.R.A.I.N. award shall receive a cash payment of **USD 5,000** to further support their studies. The successful candidate will be notified via email by **9th September 2019**. Unsuccessful candidates will not be contacted individually. The award will be presented at the ANF in Seoul, South Korea on **17th October 2019**. The successful applicant will be invited to attend the conference and present a 15 minute paper outlining their research and its application to animal nutrition and/or animal health industry. Return economy flights, meals and accommodation for ANF will be fully paid by BIOMIN.

Upon completion of their research studies, the successful applicant is encouraged to send a copy of their research abstracts to BIOMIN.

* The award is open to university students from Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Cambodia, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, New Zealand, Pakistan, Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam.
